

## Calling

**LEARN** is (re)discovering information.

You are not where you are by accident. God has a specific calling for you and your life, and once you begin to discover it, you can start replicating your faith into the people and places God has called you to. The biblical idea of God's calling for us includes being called to a specific mission to spread God's Kingdom.

Read these passages and discuss them with each other:

Isaiah 6:1-10

Galatians 1:11-24

Matthew 26:36-44

Jeremiah 1:4-19

Exodus 3:1-14, 4:8-11

Pick a passage, or more than one, and answer these questions with each other:

1. What does this passage say? (Read it twice.)
2. What is God teaching me?
3. What will I do, or change based on what I've read?

**DO** is acting on what we learned.

Share words of affirmation with each other - name the gifts/talents you see in each other, taking time to celebrate them.

Share your interests with each other - the places you are able to use your gifts/talents.

This week, ask God and a trust friend what God might be calling you to do or become.

**COACH** is reviewing what we did and evaluating how it was done.

How did your conversation(s) go regarding what God might be calling you to do or become?

What stands in the way of you doing or becoming this?

Is there a way I can be helpful to you in pursuing that?
