

## Character

**LEARN** is (re)discovering information.

The definition of Character is the “mental and moral qualities distinctive to an individual.” Those qualities are shaped by our faith in and relationship with God. As Fearless Followers, God is always improving our character as we enter into life with Him, and if our character is poor, it can quickly derail our best efforts to serve God.

Read these passages and discuss them with each other:

Galatians 5:13-26

Colossians 3:1-17

Romans 12:9-21

Genesis 39:1-22

Daniel 3:8-27

Pick a passage, or more than one, and answer these questions with each other:

1. What does this passage say? (Read it twice.)
2. What is God teaching me?
3. What will I do, or change based on what I've read?

**DO** is acting on what we learned.

Invite a pastor to meet with you, and share what you're learning about the importance of character. Then, ask the pastor to share his or her thoughts/learnings about the importance of character. How does character impact ministry? Why is character important? What is a great example of leading with good character? What about an example of leading with poor character?

**COACH** is reviewing what we did and evaluating how it was done.

What did the pastor say that stuck out to you? Why did that stick out to you?

How could you improve your character?

What areas of your character are you proud of (honesty, commitment, etc.)?
