As we get ready to launch another Reach and Restore Initiative we want to take a moment to thank you for what was accomplished through your giving last year.

Last June we opened the Linking Center down in Pullman. In the short time it's been open it has become the hub of spiritual and family life in the area. One of Pullman leaders recently told us that along with the impact of a growing number of children, the biggest surprise has been the increased involvement of parents helping with the programs and pouring into their kid's lives. For decades to come God is going to use that facility to change Pullman and expand His kingdom.

We also had the chance to visit Hope of the Nations in Tanzania this past year. Our financial support went to scholarship 50 church planters and pastors for further training. We were able to see the plans and walk through the construction of a dormitory that is being built with our funds to house future church planters that will be trained at their Bible School.

Along with impact regionally and globally, your generosity as allowed us to support the Holland Rescue Mission, the Gate down in Hamilton and to up-fit the chapel at Pine Trail Camp in Saugatuck.

As we turn the page toward this year, God has given us some incredible opportunities to tangibly show the love of Jesus to those in our cities, region and world. You can see the details of the places we are helping on enclosed card but let me highlight our overall focus.

We are especially directing much of our aid toward the next generation. Whether it's coming alongside helping schools meet the emotional needs of students in our schools to receive the help they need, aiding orphaned or marginalized child to get into permanent or safe family environments, or sponsoring students in Tanzania and Zambia to get their education so they can make a better life for themselves and improve their communities, we believe that helping the youngest and "least of these" makes a huge difference and brings a smile to the face of Jesus.

Finally, we love that we have the chance to come alongside Ann Nakimera, who did a residency with us last year at Third Coast, to plant a church in her home country of Uganda. This is what partnering around the world is all about!
