

## Hospitality

**LEARN** is (re)discovering information.

Jesus illustrated hospitality throughout the Bible by setting an example of how to serve others in radical ways. The way we receive, entertain and treat others (guests, visitors and strangers alike) reflects God working through us.

Read these passages and discuss them with each other:

Matthew 10:5-15

2 Kings 6:8-23

Genesis 18:1-8

1 Peter 4:8-11

Hebrews 13:1-3

Pick a passage, or more than one, and answer these questions with each other:

1. What does this passage say? (Read it twice.)
2. What is God teaching me?
3. What will I do, or change based on what I've read?

**DO** is acting on what we learned.

Talk about a person or group of people you find it most difficult to be hospitable toward.

Discuss what makes it difficult for you to show hospitality toward these people. Ask God to soften your heart toward these individuals and to guide you to be more hospitable towards them. Pray for the people you've discussed.

**COACH** is reviewing what we did and evaluating how it was done.

How did showing hospitality go for you this week?

What did you learn about yourself? What about God's love for you? His love for all people?
