**LEARN** is (re)discovering information.

Read these passages and discuss them with each other:

1 Corinthians 13:1-7

Luke 10:25-37

1 Samuel 17:57-18:20

Mark 12:28-33

1 John 4:7-12, 18-21

Pick a passage, or more than one, and answer these questions with each other:

1. What does this passage say? (Read it twice.)
2. What is God teaching me?
3. What will I do or change based on what I've read?

**DO** is acting on what we learned.

Talk with each other about how love has changed your life. Who has loved you well? Share with each other the name of at least one person who needs to receive Jesus' love through you. Between now and the time we connect again, how will you show that person(s) love?

**COACH** is reviewing what we did and evaluating how it was done.

When it came to showing love to the person you chose, what went well? What was difficult? In our conversations, how can we show each other Christian love?
