

## Sharing the Gospel

**LEARN** is (re)discovering information.

Jesus tells many stories of God's love for the lost: God is like a shepherd searching for one lost and vulnerable sheep. He is like a woman looking in every nook and cranny for a lost, valuable coin. He is like a father who celebrates when His lost and confused son returns home. These parables illustrate God's earnest and patient search for every person. Sharing the Gospel, then, is joining God's search to see everyone come to a relationship with Him.

Read these passages and discuss them with each other:

Acts 2:14-41

2 Corinthians 5:17-21

Romans 10:1-15

Luke 10:1-16

Mathew 28:16-20

Pick a passage, or more than one, and answer these questions with each other:

1. What does this passage say? (Read it twice.)
2. What is God teaching me?
3. What will I do, or change based on what I've read?

**DO** is acting on what we learned.
