Position Description

Title: Student Ministry Coordinator

Salary Level: VII

Leadership Development: Team Leader

Reports to: The Student Ministry Coordinator will report to the RP Student Ministry Pastor

Function: SM Coordinator (SMC) will teach, plan and create environments for students to connect with their peers, grow in their relationship with Jesus, fearlessly making him known and support parents as the main spiritual influencers in their students' lives and invest in ministry leaders/volunteers. Student Ministry Coordinator will focus primarily on Tribe (5-8th).

Hours: non-exempt, average 32 hours, weeknight and weekend hours

Leading:

- Work alongside Student Ministry team to help form teachings, experiences for weekly gatherings, and term groups.
- Teach 3-4 times a month.
- Invite, invest and inspire life group leaders/volunteers, coaching and casting vision for their unique role in the ministry.
- Provide multiple modes of communication and support to parents and caregivers (email, in person, social, etc.)
- Contribute to church partnerships, Network gatherings, collaborating and building team synergy
- Provide vision for the worship experience on program nights.
- Visit the 4th grade class once a month to build relationship with the incoming 5th grade class.
- Lead a life group in Tribe.

Planning:

- Attend and speak into Family and Student Ministry staff meetings.
- Plan, lead and execute Student Ministry events, mission trips and special services.
- Craft engaging ministry nights that align with the Fearless Family Pathway (e.g., teachings, experiences, games, activities).
- Assist in planning, leading and executing leader and student retreats.
- Work 2-3 months ahead to provide clear vision of Tribe programming and ministry volunteer needs
- Collaborate in development of curriculum for Student Ministries within the Network.
- Research and understand student and family culture

- Member or willing to become a member of a Fearless Church within 6 months of employment
